

## **Senior To-Do List:**

### **1. Check your email!!**

### **2. Log into your Naviance account! (Sept-Oct)**

- a. Naviance is where you will request transcripts, teacher recommendations, search for schools, sign up for college visits, etc. Naviance is also used for trade schools, and for military visits.
- b. **Make sure to write your password down somewhere!**
- c. See your school counselor if you need help logging in:
  - i. A-G, Mrs. Sookey, [msookey@cbrsd.org](mailto:msookey@cbrsd.org)
  - ii. H-M, Mr. Andersen, [pandersen@cbrsd.org](mailto:pandersen@cbrsd.org)
  - iii. N-Z, Mrs. Salavantis, [ksalavantis@cbrsd.org](mailto:ksalavantis@cbrsd.org)

### **3. Start looking at schools/trade schools/careers/apprenticeships/military options (Sept-Nov)**

- a. Use Google Classroom, Naviance, Cappex.com, Union reps, Recruiters, etc.
- b. Talk to your family, teachers, counselor, etc!
- c. **Sign up for college visits at Wahconah! Go to schools to visit!**
- d. **Make a list of the ones that interest you and their deadlines!**

### **4. Ask two teachers for recommendations if you have not already. (Sept-Oct)**

Think: What teachers know you well? Then: Ask in person!

### **5. Complete the [student brag sheet](#), [student activity sheet](#), and [transcript release form](#) and return to your guidance counselor. (Sept-Oct)**

### **6. If you are interested in applying to a 4 year school or applying early action/decision, **set up an appointment with your counselor** soon! If you are interested in the military, consider speaking with a recruiter! If you are interested in a trade, talk to the union/business!**

### **7. If you're planning on applying to college, and have not taken the SAT yet - sign up! (Oct)**

- a. <https://collegereadiness.collegeboard.org/sat/register> → Save this password!
- b. If you get free/reduced lunch, you are eligible for a fee waiver for the SAT - talk to your counselor if you think you qualify!

### **8. Start working on applications: (Oct-Nov)**

- a. The Common App is already open!
- b. **Start working on your college essay/essay questions**
- c. Let your counselor know when you submit a transcript request!

→ **If you're interested in going straight into your career/the workforce, start building a resume. Ask your counselor or Mrs. Grady if you need help!**

→ **If you're interested in the military, talk to recruiters and ask Mrs. Salavantis about the ASVAB! (March)**

### **9. Check for scholarship opportunities and apply for financial aid!**

- a. WRHS Naviance, Guidance Google Site, [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov), & CSS profile if applicable (click <https://profile.collegeboard.org/profile/ppi/participatingInstitutions.aspx> for a list of participating schools)

### **10. Finish out senior year strong (it still counts!!) You got this!**

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## **Important Dates:**

- **September-November:** Set up an appointment with your Guidance Counselor!
- **September-November:** College/Military visits - sign up on Naviance!
- **November 1/Nov. 15:** Early Action/Early Decision for many colleges
- **November 6:** SAT - sign up by Oct. 8!
- **December 4:** SAT - Sign up by Nov. 4!
- **December 11:** ACT - Sign up by Nov. 5!
- **January 1/Jan 15:** Regular application deadline for many schools
- **May 1st:** College decision day
