STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

Goal: To increase student growth toward meeting targets in ELA, math and science as measured by school achievement targets.

Focus Areas:

- 1. Increase teacher capacity through direct coaching from K-8 Instructional Coach.
- 2. Provide high quality staff development through the DESE Tiered Literacy Academy.
- 3. Create action plans for targeted interventions strategies based on data analysis in CI meetings with a focus on UDL in order to reach all learners.
- 4. Provide targeted, mastery oriented feedback to teachers regarding the quality and rigor of instruction and implementation of UDL strategies.
- 5. Implement quarterly benchmarks to continue to align curriculum with state standards and identify gaps in learning.
- 6. Participate in bi-monthly data teams, 6-8, to analyze student progress toward end of the year Math, ELA and science benchmarks.
- 7. Provide high quality staff development and coaching in the components of the Eureka Math program, I Science and Units of Study.

SCHOOL CLIMATE

Goal: To improve school climate by focusing on communication, consistency, and leadership.

Focus Areas:

- 1. Develop a Turn-Around Plan to increase overall achievement.
- 2. Create a clear focus, vision and align all decisions.
- 3. Clear lines of communication with consistency among building and district level administrators.
- 4. Increase teacher capacity to provide leadership opportunities.

PBIS

Goal: To provide a safe and positive learning environment where appropriate behavior is the norm by implementing a schoolwide Positive Behavior Intervention Support Initiative.

Focus Areas:

- 1. Work with consultants to implement a school wide PBIS model
- 2. Participate in the PBIS Academy through Department of Elementary and Secondary Education
- 3. Review school discipline plan and office referrals and revise as needed based on PBIS initiative
- 4. Develop a PBIS Team with parent, administrator, teacher and specialists.

SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING

Goal: Create and support a climate that is physically and emotionally supportive, that honors diversity, and increases opportunities for student learning.

Focus Areas:

- 1. Implement Anti-bias education program; A World of Difference
- 2. Support the ongoing work of the school climate team, student climate team (safe measures), and Nessacus Gay Straight Alliance to support the needs and growth of all students
- 3. Implementation of Anti-bullying programing through the DA's office and outside programming
- 4. Review bullying data monthly to identify and develop plans to target areas of concern
